8. 2010 ST Scientific Program (1/2)

- ❑ *Many thanks to all science secretaries and session conveners !*
- ❑ Orals versus posters :
 - 2008: 429 abstracts , 25 ST oral blocks => 17.16 abstracts / OB
 - 2009: 401 abstracts, 25 ST oral blocks => 16.04 abstracts / OB
 - 2010: 412 abstracts, 24 ST oral blocks => 18.72 abstracts / OB
 - Final ST 2010 oral / poster ratio: 36 % - 64 %
 - Final EGU 2010 oral / poster ratio: 32 % - 68 %
- ❑ ST : 2.7 % of total EGU 2010 abstracts
- ❑ Maximum number of ST oral blocks determined by:
 - EGU boundary conditions on room availability
 - Oral sessions only in the first four daily slots and the other papers be given in posters.

At AGU, the oral to poster rate is even lower
