Total: 465 abstracts (-11.2% with respect to GA2014 and + 7% with respect to GA2013)

oral: 29% distributed over 26 oral slots

PICO: 11%

poster: 60%

History: 2014: 524 (18 oral slots)

2012: 335 (14 oral slots)

2011: 305

2010: 180

Ari-Matti Harri reported on the status of the Journal by announcing that GI Journal will be indexed on Scopus since the next year and that the procedures to activate the request of the Impact Factor have been just started. The hope is to have GI Journal indexed in ISI-Web of Science on July 2016. In addition, Ari-Matti Harri reported about the issue on the lengthy period for the review stage; he claimed that a solution could be to send an initial invitation to more than two potential reviewers and inform the remaining persons that their service is no longer needed once the first two reviewers had accepted the task.

4. Christiaan Huygens Medal

Award 2014
